## Synopsis

The peasant girl Giselle discovers the true aristocratic  
identity of her lover Albrecht – and that he is betrothed  
to another. In despair at the revelation, Giselle dies of  
heartbreak. Her spirit enters the realm of the Wilis –  
ghosts of women who were betrayed by their lovers and  
died before their wedding day. All men that come across  
their path are compelled to dance themselves to death.  
As Albrecht verges on meeting with the same fate,  
Giselle intervenes with her love from beyond the grave,  
saving Albrecht and releasing her own soul from the Wilis.
